



CODE OF CONDUCT

PLAYERS

- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you need clarification, have your Captain approach the official during a break or after the game.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team – your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport – applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Show respect to and acknowledge opponents and officials – (eg: shake hands and say things like 'good luck', 'thanks for the game', 'thanks umpire'). Finish the game with three cheers.
- Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents – without them there would be no competition.
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit – not just to please parents and coaches.
- Play fair – verbal abuse of officials, sledging other players (including vilification) or deliberately distracting, hurting or provoking an opponent will not be tolerated.
- Wear your club uniform with pride and ensure your behaviour reflects the values and culture of the club.
- Respect the role of the coach and listen to their instructions and feedback.
- Speak to an adult you trust if you have an issue, feel unsafe or are concerned about someone else.
